Professor Efraim Inbar

President of JISS

Prof. Inbar is an expert on Israeli strategic doctrine, public opinion on national security issues, US Middle East policy, Middle East process, and Israel's foreign policy. He is professor emeritus in international relations at Bar-Ilan University and former founder and director of its BESA Center for Strategic Studies. He has been a visiting professor at Georgetown, Johns Hopkins and Boston universities; a visiting scholar at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars; a Manfred Warner NATO Fellow; and a visiting fellow at the (London-based) International Institute for Strategic Studies. He was president of the Israel Association of International Studies; and a member of the Academic Committee of the IDF History Department. He has authored five books and edited fourteen collections of scholarly articles



Major General (ret.) Yaakov Amidror

The Anne and Greg Rosshandler Senior Fellow at JISS

Gen. Amidror was National Security Advisor to Prime Minister Netanyahu and chairman of the National Security Council (April 2011-November 2013). He served for 36 years in senior IDF posts (1966-2002), including commander of the Military Colleges (including the National Defense College, Staff and Command College, and Tactical Command Academy), military secretary to the Minister of Defense, director of the Intelligence Analysis Division in Military Intelligence, and chief intelligence officer of the Northern Command. He is the author of three books on intelligence and military strategy.



Colonel (ret.) Dr. Eran Lerman

Vice President of the JISS

Dr. Lerman was deputy director for foreign policy and international affairs at the National Security Council in the Israeli Prime Minister's Office. He held senior posts in IDF Military Intelligence for over 20 years. He also served for eight years as director of the Israel and Middle East office of the American Jewish Committee. He teaches in the Middle East studies program at Shalem College in Jerusalem, and in post-graduate programs at Tel Aviv University and the National Defense College. He is an expert on Israel's foreign relations, and on the Middle East. He holds a Ph.D. from the London School of Economics, and a mid-career MPA from Harvard University.



Dr. Oshrit Birvadker

Dr. Oshrit Birvadker studies the foreign and defense policy of India, Israel-India relations, and India's ties to Gulf countries. She also is an advocate for the welfare of the Indian Jewish community in Israel.



Professor Hillel Frisch

Hillel Frisch is professor emeritus at Bar-llan University, Israel and former Senior Researcher in the Begin-Sadat (BESA) Center for Strategic Studies. Amongst his latest studies are "Rethinking the "Arab Spring": Winners and Losers," Middle East Quarterly (2021) "The Palestinian Military, Two Not One," Oxford Handbook on Military and Security Studies (2021), "Jordan and Hamas," Handbook on Jordan, 2019, and "Assessing Iranian Soft Power in the Arab World from Google Trends," The Journal for Interdisciplinary Middle Eastern Studies 2019.



Prof. Eytan Gilboa

Senior Fellow

Prof. Eytan Gilboa is an expert on US Israel relations, international communication, and public diplomacy. He was the founding Head of both the School of Communication and the Center for International Communication at Bar-llan University. He has been a senior fellow at the USC Center on Public Diplomacy. He also was a senior research associate at the BESA Center for Strategic Studies. He received his MA and PhD from Harvard University and has been a visiting professor in several top universities including Harvard, Tufts, UCLA, USC, Georgetown, the University of Hamburg, the Vienna School of International Studies, and the University of Pennsylvania. He published many books and numerous articles and book chapters and won several international awards.



Dr. Yagil Henkin

Dr. Yagil Henkin is a military historian, specializing in urban warfare and counterinsurgency. Dr. Henkin also teaches military history at the IDF Command and Staff College.

Dr. Emmanuel Navon

Senior Fellow

Dr. Navon is a lecturer in international relations at Tel Aviv University and at the Herzliya Interdisciplinary Center. He is also a senior fellow at the Kohelet Policy Forum, and an analyst for i24News. He has authored three books and numerous articles in professional journals. Dr. Navon graduated from Sciences-Po Paris and earned his Ph.D. in International Relations from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.



Dr. Uzi Rubin

Senior Fellow

Dr. Rubin was the founder and first director (1991-1999) of the Israel Missile Defense Organization in the Israel Ministry of Defense, which developed, produced, and deployed the country's first national defense shield – the Arrow missile. He subsequently served as Senior Director for Proliferation and Technology in the National Security Council (1999-2001), and directed several defense programs at the Israel Aerospace Industries and in the defense ministry. He was twice awarded the Israel Defense Prize (1996 and 2003). He was also awarded the US Missile Defense Agency "David Israel" Prize (2000). He has been a visiting scholar at the Stanford Center for International Security and Arms Control.



Dr. Pnina Shuker

Fellow

Dr. Pnina Shuker specializes in national security, public opinion, and foreign policy issues. Her doctoral dissertation focused on the perception of democratic societies being sensitive to casualties and the impact of dealing with strategic threats, through a comparative analysis between Britain, Israel, and the United States.



Professor Colonel (ret.) Gabi Siboni

Senior Fellow

Prof. Siboni was director of the military and strategic affairs program, and the cyber research program, of the INSS (2006-2020), where he founded academic journals on these matters. He serves as a senior consultant to the IDF and other Israeli security organizations and the security industry. He holds a B.Sc. and M.Sc. in engineering from Tel Aviv University and a Ph.D. in Geographic Information Systems (GIS) from Ben-Gurion University. Prof. Siboni is an expert on cyber security, military strategy, and technology.



Dr. Jonathan Spyer

Senior Fellow

Dr. Spyer is an expert on Syria, Iraq, radical Islamic groups, and Kurds. He is one of the very few Western/Israeli experts to have traveled extensively in Syria, Iraq, and the Kurdish areas in recent years. He is the author of Days of the Fall: A Reporter's Journey in the Syria and Iraq Wars, and The Transforming Fire: the Rise of the Israel-Islamist Conflict. He is a regular contributor to Jane's Intelligence Review, has published in leading journals and media outlets including Middle East Quarterly, Times (of London), Foreign Policy, Wall Street Journal, Guardian, Atlantic, Australian, National Post, Globe and Mail, Jerusalem Post; and has appeared on CNN, Al-Jazeera, Fox, BBC, Sky, and other outlets. He holds a Ph.D. in international relations from the London School of Economics.

Dr. Hay Eytan Cohen Yanarocak is an expert on contemporary Turkish politics and foreign policy, Turkish-Israeli relations, and the Kurds. He is co-editor of Turkeyscope, a publication of the Moshe Dayan Center for Middle Eastern and African Studies at Tel Aviv University.
